Harmon, Lois Marjorie Pinney died on June 7, 2014, at Avery Heights in Hartford, CT, after a short illness. She was born on March 23, 1924, in Hartford, and lived her entire life in the area. She is survived by her husband Harold (Hal), her children Norah and Warren, grandchildren Sarah, Christopher, and Alissa, her older sister Lillian and many nephews and nieces. Two sisters preceded her in death - Arlene and Alice. After graduating from Hall High School, West Hartford, she worked briefly for an insurance company. After completing nurses training in 1946, she worked in the operating rooms of Hartford until 1955, when she resigned her nursing position to spend her senior year on the UCONN campus. She graduated in 1956, and married Hal in September of that year. They lived in Manchester from 1961 until 2013, when they moved to Avery Heights. She was an active member of Central Baptist Church in Hartford for more than 60 years, teaching in the church school and singing in the Sanctuary Choir. She was a summer counselor at Camp Wightman in North Stonington for many years and became active in Girl Scouts, as a leader, troop organizer and Manchester permanent Memorial parade committee member, serving as chair for one year. She was an active member of Church Women United, a nationwide ecumenical organization, and several Baptist organizations. Calling hours will begin at 9 am, Saturday, June 14, 2014, at Central Baptist Church, 457 Main St, Hartford, directly after which will be a Service of Remembrance at 10:30 am, also at Central. A burial service will follow in
