Loreto B. D'Alesandris, 88, the loving husband of the late Lorraine B. (LaForest) D'Alesandris, passed away peacefully Sunday May 4, 2014 at his home in West Hartford. Born in Hartford, CT on July 2, 1925, the son of the late Crescenzo and Josephine (Basile) D'Alesandris. He was a U.S. Navy Veteran of WW II and the Korean War.
