Luis Horacio Macedo Mira, 78, beloved husband of Maria Eugenia Romeiras Palma Mira, of West Hartford, died on Monday, July 3, 2006 at St. Francis Hospital. Born May 10, 1928 in Montemor-O-Novo, Portugal, son of the late Francisco Macedo Mira and Antonia Varela Mira, he made his home in the Hartford area for over 36 years and during that time he was also member of the Portuguese Club of Hartford and a communicant of Our Lady of Fatima Church. He was employed for 26 years at St. Francis Hospital retiring from the operating room in 1995, and was also a volunteer cameraman at T.V. Portugal for 13 years. He enjoyed soccer and especially Benfica, his lifelong soccer team and was rooting for Portugal to win the World Cup in '06. He also enjoyed fishing, dancing and his afternoon espresso.
