Luke was a hard-working, highly skilled member of New England Regional Council of Carpenters, Local 43, in Hartford for five years and was employed by New England Drywall. In 2006 he won 1st place at the New England Regional Council of Carpenters Apprenticeship contest in the interior systems category. Besides his parents, Luke leaves his children Mikayla and Lucas who were the light of his life. He also leaves his sister Jennifer Bordonaro and her husband Matthew of Wallingford, his brothers; Bret of Portland, OR and Jack of West Hartford, many aunts, uncles, cousins and his girlfriend Evelyn Hernandez; all of whom he loved and cherished.
