Marcia Murphy Geary “Marcy” passed away peacefully at home on Thursday, February 5, 2019. Marcy was born on October 30, 1939 in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania as the only child of Jack and Sophia Murphy.

She graduated from Carnegie Mellon University in 1961 and began a career as a teacher in the Pittsburgh School System and later taught in Washington D.C. and Maryland. While in D.C., she met and married the love of her life, her husband of nearly 53 years, William J. Geary “Bill”. Being an only child, Marcy fully embraced the chaos and excitement that comes with marrying into a large family.

She was present, curious, smart, and had a beautiful sense of humor that immediately lit up the room. Those that knew her will remember her as being welcoming and always talking about her children and grandchildren with pride and excitement.

In addition to her parents, Marcy was predeceased by her brother and sister in laws Stephen and Ruth Geary, and John William Geary, and uncles and aunts William Murphy, Ward and Ruth Murphy, Helen Lamb, and cousin David Murphy.
