Margaret J. Partridge, 88, died Thursday July 28, 2004 in West Hartford where she had lived for most of her life. Born in Pawtucket, RI, she was educated in the Pawtucket School System and was a 1937 graduate of Brown University. Miss Partridge taught at the American School for the Deaf in West Hartford, and at schools for the deaf in Malvern and Doncaster England. She was an active friend of St. John's Episcopal Church deaf ministry in West Hartford. She is survived by her sister Elizabeth P. Green of Pawtucket, RI, her nephew Wesley Green and his wife Pearl of Green Valley, AZ, and their son Charles J. Green.
