Mark S. Chapell, of West Hartford, CT, passed away 3/ 22/12. Born in New Haven, CT, to Anthony and Marion Chapell, Mark earned his Ph.D. in Psychology at Temple University and was a professor at Rowan University, NJ. Devoted to his students, to whom he was also an academic advisor and mentor, he received many teaching awards throughout his career. As a researcher, he published many highly regarded papers. The Chapell family lived in Latin America and Spain for 10 years while Mark's father worked for the US State Department. Mark always excelled academically. He was also a great soccer player. In 1967 he was an all state fullback on an undefeated team at Conard High School, W. Hartford. Mark is predeceased by his mother Marion Chapell, and survived by his father, Anthony Chapell, his wife Phyllis, brother Chris and his wife Carol and their children, Chris and Nella, brother John, sister Susan Chapell and sister Cathy Chapell Pallotti and her husband Francis.
