Nancy Catherine Theresa O'Neil Hursey 78, beloved wife of Francis ("Frank") X. Hursey passed away peacefully on October 12, 2025 at her home in West Hartford. She was born on December 29, 1946 in Hartford, Ct. She attended Mount St. Joseph's High School and graduated from St. Francis School of Nursing in 1967.

Nancy was married to Frank for 58 years and was a devoted mother to her children Kristin (Dennis), Heidi (Peter) and Jon (Lori). Her children were her pride and joy. She found great happiness in her 9 grandchildren, Clayton (Lauren), Dylan, Hannah, Grace, Luke, Emma, Rose, Eli, and Gabriel. Nancy was preceded in death by her parents Edward and Dorothy O'Neil, as well as her brother in law Bill Tolar, and sister in law Joan Hursey. She is survived by her sister Mary Jane Caffyn (Bill), her brother David O'Neil (Karen), her sister in law Judy Turner (Jim), and sister in law Jane Tolar.
