Nancy Pedersen, beloved wife of Mark Kosinski, died November 27, 2025, at UCONN Medical, in Farmington. She was born in Webster, Massachusetts to Dorothy (Hubbard) and Arnold Pedersen. Nancy graduated (high school) from Mount Hermon Academy in 1969, BA degree earned at McGill University in 1973, then MLS degree in library science from Simmons College in 1987 and attended the MFA at Boston University.

Nancy married Mark Kosinski on August 11, 1986, in Webster, MA. In addition to her husband, she is survived by her daughters Emma and Celia, son-in-law Matt Fletcher and grand-daughter, Margo, Nancy leaves two brothers, Charles (Deborah) Pedersen of Upton, MA., and John (Derrie) of Springfield, Illinois.
