Nicholas Anthony Notte, Sr., 84, of West Hartford, beloved husband of the late Antonette M. Notte, and son of the late Angelina and Cosmo Notte, died Monday, September 10, 2012, at St. Mary Home in West Hartford. He was born in Torrington, CT on June 15, 1928 and lived at the home he built in West Hartford for almost 60 years.
