December 30, 1921 - April 24, 2007

Arthur H. Manoogian Ozzie, 85, of West Hartford died Tuesday, April 24, 2007 at home. He was born on December 30, 1921, the son of the late Harry and Natalie Manoogian in Hartford and moved to West Hartford in 1936. He graduated from Hall High School, worked for the Water Bureau of the City of Hartford, and then as plumber and steamfitter for many years. He was a proud member of the West Hartford Regents, 37th degree Shriner, Masonic Lodge #4. Ozzie was also a charter member of the West Hartford YMCA Indian Guides, commissioner of Boy Scouts of St Timothy's Church, member of AARP, Red Cross volunteer, and a tireless volunteer for West Hartford Senior Center activities. In 2001 Ozzie and his wife Angie received the Best Volunteer award for the West Hartford Senior Center, having taught ceramics there for years and having taken those ceramics to many local assisted living homes, bringing much happiness to those residents. He loved doing crafts, gardening, traveling, and stamp collecting. Ozzie was a devoted Christian and a member of the St Stephen's Armenian Apostolic Church in New Britain. He leaves his beloved wife Angeline Cantone Manoogian of 62 years, and his beloved children: daughter Sandra and her husband Tom Pearce of Fargo, North Dakota, and grandchildren David and Elizabeth; and son Arthur Jr. and his wife Jean of San Clemente, CA and grandchild Brian. He leaves his sister Elizabeth Manoogian of West Hartford. He was preceded in death by his brother Charles and sister-in-law Betty Manoogian, by his niece Suzanne Lehnertz of Kansas City, by his nephew David Manoogian of Washington DC,
