Patricia K. Seremet, of West Hartford, died Saturday May 20, 2006 at Hartford Hospital. Born in Hartford, October 10, 1947, the daughter of the late Joseph and Angela Wall Kenny, she had made her home in West Hartford the past 34 years. Pat was a graduate of Kingswood Oxford School in West Hartford, and Newton College of the Sacred Heart, Class of 1969, in Newton, MA. She was a mother, writer, reporter, columnist, editor, friend, and personality, working first for Imprint Publications and then the Hartford Courant. She was the author of The Courant's popular "Java" column. Pat is survived by her children; Justin of Los Angeles, CA; Scott of Boston, MA, and Angela of West Hartford. Her brother Sean Kenny and his wife Sheryl of Bendbrook, TX, her aunts; Marie Wall of Stuart, FL, and Helene Wall Gersuny of Peacedale, RI also survive her. 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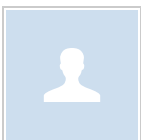
