Margaret Brennan Buck, wife of the late Thomas R. Buck, mother of the late Thomas A. Buck, and mother of John R. Buck, died at the age of 92 at her home in West Hartford. Peg had been a resident of West Hartford since 1923. She was a graduate of Mt. St. Joseph's Academy and St. Joseph's College with her teaching degree. During WWII she worked as an engineer at Pratt and Whitney helping to design the first American jet engine. After the war she taught briefly in the West Hartford School system, before leaving to raise her two sons. With her husband Tom, Peggy helped found the Hartford Branch of Meals on Wheels. She helped found and served as president of the St. Francis Women's Auxiliary and worked in the thrift shop. She would also serve as president of the volunteers at the Hartford Regional Center in Newington. Peg was active in many literary and volunteer organizations. In addition to her son John she leaves behind many dear friends and family who loved her deeply. A special blessing to Beverly Morris, who cared for her with love and compassion in her declining years. Funeral services will be Monday March 29th with a Mass of Christian Burial at 10:00 am in St. Peter Claver Church, 47 Pleasant St. West Hartford. Burial will follow in Fairview Cemetery.
