Philip J. Kennedy, 82, of West Hartford beloved husband of "Nancy" Marion H. Kennedy, died Monday, July 12, 2010. Philip was born in Norwich, the son of Maurice J. and Margaret O'Brien Kennedy. Philip attended St. Thomas Seminary before joining the U.S. Navy. Following his honorable discharge, Philip attended and graduated from Hillyer College in 1950, later receiving his law degree from UCONN in 1971. Philip worked as a Special Agent for the IRS for 27 years, and as an Inspector for the Chief States Attorney Office for 10 years. Philip was a proud member of the First Company Governors Foot Guard. In addition to his wife, Philip is survived by his five sons, and eleven grandchildren; Peter J. Kennedy and his wife Kate of Colebrook; James P. Kennedy and his wife Jordana of Avon and their children, Madison, Hannah, and Jessica; John F. Kennedy and his wife Deborah of Barkhamsted and their children Philip, Nicholas, and Angela; Patrick M. Kennedy and his wife Melissa of Colchester and their children William and Matthew; Thomas P. Kennedy and his wife Christie of West Hartford and their children Morgan, Graham and Charlotte. Three sisters and a brother additionally survive him; Jerome Kennedy and his wife Charlotte of West Hartford, Margaret Samolyk and her husband Edward of Windsor, Eleanor DeMaio of Boston, MA, and Lucille O'Connell and her husband Neil of Unionville. Philip was predeceased by two infant daughters and his brothers, Maurice, Richard, John, Justin and Ralph.
