



Robert E. Walsh

August 6, 1933 - April 25, 2009

Robert E Walsh, 75, of West Hartford passed away peacefully, after a long illness, on Saturday, April 25, 2009, surrounded by his loving family. He was born in Bridgeport, CT on August 6, 1933, the son of the late Ruth Myers Walsh and the late William J. Walsh. He often noted that he was one of Trumbull's only 1933 twins.

He leaves his beloved wife of fifty years, Barbara Czaplicki Walsh, son Robert E. Walsh Jr and wife Rachel of West Hartford, daughter Martha Kehoe and husband Paul of South Glastonbury, daughter Monica Swanson and husband Brian of Coventry, twin brother Richard A. Walsh and brother W. Kevin Walsh and their families, granddaughters Margaret Kehoe, Meredith Swanson and Geneva Swanson, and grandson Brendan Kehoe.

Bob graduated from the Loomis School in 1951 and Bowdoin College cum laude in 1955. He received a J.D. from the University of Connecticut Law School in 1962 and an LL.M from New York University Law School in 1963. Bob was formerly a Professor of Law at the University of Connecticut Law School. He was an Assistant Attorney General from 1975 to 1989. For 13 years he was a Connecticut Small Claims and Traffic Magistrate, while maintaining a private practice of law.

Bob lived in West Hartford for most of his life, and was a communicant of St. Timothy's since 1964. He loved vacationing on Cape Cod and enjoyed swimming in his later years. In the course of his life, Bob was involved in many forms of volunteer work, including The Urban League and American

Legion Baseball.
