Atty. Robert F. Downey, 93, of West Hartford, died Wednesday Dec. 19, 2007. Born in Hartford, the son of the late James Louis and Mary Conway Downey, he had lived in West Hartford most of his life. He was a graduate of Wm. H. Hall High School 1931, The College of the Holy Cross 1935, and the Hartford College of Law 1938, now the University of Connecticut School of Law. Bob worked as an attorney for the Veterans Administration for most of his career. He was a U.S. Army veteran of World War II, serving in the Ardennes, Central Europe, Northern France, the Rhineland and the Battle of the Bulge.
