Robert H. Barley, 61, of West Hartford died peacefully and with his family at his side on Monday, September 24 in Hartford Hospital after a valiant battle with cancer. Bob was born on February 16, 1946 in Milford, Connecticut, to Grace and Howard Barley. He lived his young life in Milford graduating from Jonathan Law High School. He completed a degree in Insurance at the University of Connecticut where he was a member of Tau Kappa Epsilon Fraternity and went on to earn an MBA from the University of Hartford. After serving in the active Army Bob served another 20 years in the 826th Military Intelligence Battalion as a Lt. Colonel in the Reserves.
