Roland O. Steben, 77, the former owner of Steben Motors and Auto Body, Inc. in West Hartford, died Tuesday June 21, 2005, at Hartford Hospital. Born in Hartford, the son of the late Edward and Georgiana Gauvin Steben, he lived in East Hartford for 38 years, moving to West Hartford in 1986. He was the husband of the late Mary Celeo Steben. He started his business as an auto glass replacement shop in 1957 expanding into auto repair and service on Park Rd. in West Hartford where it is owned and operated today by his sons. Roland was a member of the West Hartford Rotary Club, the East Hartford Lions Club, and the Knights of Columbus. Mr. Steben was a avid skier and sailor. He is survived by his four children and their families; David Steben, his wife Jody, and their children Jeremy and Meredith of Avon; Paul Steben, his wife Donna, and their children Nicholas and Juliana; of West Hartford, Peter Steben and his wife Christine of Avon, and Laura Steben of Breckenridge, CO and her close friend Ben DeJulio.
