Ronald R. Biederman, loving husband and devoted father, passed peacefully with family by his side on November 14, 2024. He was born in Hartford on October 19, 1938, to the late Bernhard and Dorothy (Staph) Biederman. Ron had a lifelong love of education, earning his BS, MS, and PhD at the University of Connecticut. He began his career as a professor at UCONN where he taught for six years. Following this he had a distinguished career at Worcester Polytechnic Institute in the Department of Materials Science and Engineering for over 35 years. UConn also recognized Ron into the Academy of Distinguished Engineers. During this time, he was also called upon to serve on a committee analyzing the steel from the World Trade Center. Ron was a member of the Academic Honor Society at WPI. He was recognized as a Technical Fellow of ASM International, was an author on numerous technical publications, and a co-inventor on several metallurgical patents. He was always especially proud of the accomplishments of the many students he had throughout his career.

Ron had a variety of hobbies including gardening, photography, and travel. He was an accomplished traveler, visiting 82 different countries during his lifetime. When sticking close to home, he enjoyed spending time on Cape Cod. He is survived by his devoted wife, Patricia (Sataro) Biederman; sons Brian and wife Michelle, Scott and wife Nancy; granddaughters Katelynn and Rebecca; stepdaughters Gina Sataro, Christina Sataro and husband Matt MacNayr; brother David and wife Diane of Columbia, TN; and numerous

nieces and nephews. Ron was predeceased by his parents; older brothers Bernhard, William, and Robert; sisters Dorothy, Margaret, and Jean; and his first wife, Jo-Ann (Zwarick) Biederman.
