



## Rose Trocchi Pricone

Rose T. Pricone, 96, passed away peacefully Sunday, January 7, at her home in West Hartford, her two children at her side. Rose is the widow of Salvatore J. Pricone who died November 14, 2008. She is survived by her daughter, Cynthia Pricone Jacobs of West Hartford and son, Richard Pricone Price of Berlin. She is also survived by her brother, Anthony Trocchi, of Simsbury.

Born September 15, 1921 in Simsbury, Rose was the youngest child of Emidio and Matilda (Salvatore) Trocchi. The Trocchi family moved to the Wilson section of Windsor in 1929 where Rose attended public schools and graduated from John Fitch High School in 1939.

After graduation, Rose was employed in Hartford at Stackpole, Moore, Tryon Clothiers followed by the law firm of Rago & Gould. She married her soulmate, Sal, in 1948 and moved to West Hartford. After raising her children, Rose returned to work at Advo Financial Services and the Connecticut General Life Insurance Company.
