Seymour George Reitman, 98, beloved husband of Shirley Reitman, died January 4, 2024 while in residence at Duncaster in Bloomfield, CT. Born in Philadelphia on April 30, 1925 to Elizabeth and Harry Reitman, Seymour and his brother Morty were raised in Atlantic City, N.J. where he worked in the family's restaurant until he graduated from Atlantic City High School. He enlisted in the army at 17, fought during the Battle of the Bulge and was involved in the liberation of the Buchenwald concentration camp. He is a recipient of the Bronze Star.

Returning home, he met his future wife Shirley, on a blind date and after marrying, they moved to Washington D.C. where he obtained his law degree from George Washington University. Over the years they lived in Milwaukee, and Fort Wayne, IND before settling in the Hartford area as a vice president at The Traveler's Insurance Company heading the Life, Health Marketing Group Dept. and raising three children.

Upon retirement in 1987, he and Shirley took up sailing on their boat "Cash Value" and traveled extensively throughout the US and Internationally.

He is survived by his son Bill and daughter April, grandson Jake and daughter-in-law Sandra. Seymour was predeceased by his wife, his son Larry and son-in-law Steve.
