Stephania ?Stella? Mezochow, 89, of West Hartford, widow of John Mezochow, died Monday, December 27, 2004 in Haverford, PA where she had lived since 2000. Stella was born in 1915 in Hartford the daughter of the late Philip and Anna Yasna Kosar. Stella was the retired executive secretary to eight Connecticut State Supreme Court Chief Justices. She was a charter member of the Nutmeg Chapter of the National Secretaries Association, which became the Professional Secretaries International. Stella was active with American Legion Auxiliary Unit 96; C.S.E.A Chapter 401, and the Women of St. James?s Episcopal Church. During WWII Stella was a Volunteer Nurse?s aide at Hartford Hospital while her beloved husband John served in the U.S. Army; she was on duty the night of the Hartford Circus Fire and worked with the doctors and nurses to provide relief and treatment for the fire victims. She is survived by her son Dr. John Mezochow and his wife Dr. Emily A. Blumberg, on Merion, PA.; grandchildren Alyssa and Gabrielle Mezochow; a sister Julia and her husband Patrick Ricci of Wethersfield; a sister in law Pauline Kosar of Florida; as well as many nieces and nephews. In addition to her husband Stella was predeceased by a brother Dr. Walter P. Kosar. Funeral services will be Friday, December 31, 10 a.m. at St. James?s Episcopal Church 1018 Farmington Ave. West Hartford, 06107. Burial will follow in Fairview Cemetery.
