Thomas Michael "Tommy" Harrigan, passed away peacefully at his home in West Hartford, on Monday, April 26, 2021 at the age of 60. Tommy was born in Hartford, CT on October 17, 1960, to Robert and Jeanne Harrigan. He attended St. Thomas the Apostle, Hall High, and Central Connecticut State University. Tommy had recently completed Harvard Law School's Zero-L Learning Experience courses. Tommy spent his younger years working in the restaurant industry, providing him the opportunity to travel to France where he further cultivated his lifelong love of food, wine, and entertaining. He worked as a stockbroker for Buell Securities for the last 30 years and for over 20 years as a first responder, concluding his service at American Medical Response. A lifelong member and past President of the Friendly Sons of St. Patrick, Tommy was named Irishman of the Year in 2017. He was an avid darts player, competing locally for the Irish American Home and the American Legion. He was a member of the Lenola Society as well as a winemaker and collector, winning both international and national competitions for his wines. Tommy was predeceased by his father, Robert Shaw Harrigan, Jr. He is survived by his loving, devoted wife of 30 years, Mary-Anne "Cupcake" Harrigan.
