Timothy Cooley, 83, of Bloomfield, beloved husband of Kathryn Cooley, died Sunday, March 18, 2018. Tim was born in Hartford and would live in the greater Hartford area for most of his life. He graduated from St. Paul's School in Concord, New Hampshire, then Yale Class of 1956, and the Wharton School of Business at Penn. Between Yale and Wharton, Tim was an officer in the US Navy, serving as a bombardier navigator aboard Douglas A3D Skywarrior aircraft. He worked as a financial consultant for Williams Inference Service prior to his retirement. He was very active in his community, serving on the Board at ADRC at the Gengras Center, volunteering at the School for Young Children at St. Joseph University, a member of Asylum Hill Congregational Church in Hartford and St. Alban's Episcopal Church in Simsbury, president of the Windsor Recovery Club, and was active at the East Haddam Fishing and Game Club. In addition to his wife he is survived by his four children: Edmond Cooley (Anne) of Orford, NH, Richard Cooley (Lindsay Butler) of Seattle, Timothy C. Cooley of New York City, and Elizabeth Rademacher (David) of Los Alamos, New Mexico. He will also be deeply missed by his three grandchildren: Timothy J. and Peter Rademacher, and Abigail Cooley; as well as his three brothers, Samuel P.
