Tomme Mikhal Coleman, born in Hartford, CT on June 14, 1979 and raised in West Hartford. Mikhal was an early graduate of Hall High School. Mikhal excelled at sports, holding the freshman high jump record in addition to playing hockey, basketball, baseball, football, and track. In the professional world he also excelled. He studied modeling with John Casablancas, and ran his own landscaping business to fund his studies at the Connecticut School of Broadcasting where he also graduated early. This helped fuel his lifelong passion of the recording arts, from producing and DJing to performing his own original music. In addition to the performing arts, Mikhal was also accomplished in the insurance and mortgage underwriting field, starting in an entry-level position and rising to Marketing Manager, where he was especially skilled at relating to his clients and this openness and warmth extended to everyone. Mikhal was a compassionate, caring man and citizen. He stopped several times at accidents and led rescues while waiting for the police. Mikhal is survived by his daughters; Desiree, age 18, Mikaylah, age 15, and Tiana Coleman, age 12 and their mother Christine McIlduff, as well as his daughter Emmaliah Coleman, age 5 and her mother Dawn Giacobini. He is also survived by his Father Tomme Coleman, his step mother Yvette Thibodeau and his Mother Grace Anne Kramer. 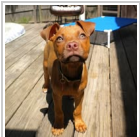
