



## Tyler Bush

August 9, 1988 - December 22, 2007

Tyler William Bush of West Hartford, died suddenly on Saturday, December 22, 2007. Born in Hartford on August 9, 1988, he was the beloved son of Ronald L. and Carlene Dahill Bush of West Hartford. In addition to his parents he leaves a sister, Allison Bush, currently residing in London, England; his grandmothers, Janet Dahill of West Hartford and Betty Bush Rowland of Meadville, PA; his uncle and godfather, Rob Dahill, aunt Susan and cousins Katie and Lizzie Dahill of New Canaan, CT; his uncle Brian Bush and aunt Sheryl of Phoenix, AZ; his godmother, Laura Ficks of West Hartford; and a large extended family.
