Valentino Donato Clementino, 95, husband of Mae Colgan Clementino, of West Hartford, died Thursday, February 15, 2007. Born in Hartford, the son of the late Antonio and Alessandria Sforza Clementino, he made his home in the Hartford area all of his life. He and his family moved to West Hartford in 1966 and spent their summers at Columbia Lake. Valentino graduated from Boston University and went on to receive his law degree from Boston University School of Law. He was a past president of the Hartford Bar Assoc, a member of the Connecticut Bar Assoc, the Windsor Rod and Gun Club, and was past president of the Young Italian American Assoc.
