Vincent Arthur Supple Sr., 87, husband of the late Helen Supple of Sarasota FL and formerly of Old Lyme Shores CT, died Monday December 26, 2005 in Florida. Vincent was born in Elmira, NY, the son of Thomas and Sarah McNaney Supple. He was a Detective Sergeant with the Hartford Police Department for 25 years, an instructor for the Hartford Police Academy, as well as Clerk of the District Court.
