Vytautas Pileika 88, of West Hartford CT passed away on Tuesday January 31, 2017 at St. Francis Hospital, Hartford CT. He was born in Kaunas, Lithuania on May 29, 1928 to Juozas Pileika and Vanda (Maikauskaite) Pileika and came to the United States in 1950. He proudly served in the United States Army during the Korean War. Vytautas married Grazina (Dapkute) in April of 1954 and attended University of Connecticut where he received an Electrical Engineering degree. Vytautas continued his education and completed a Masters in Engineering from UCONN and a Masters in Business Administration from University of Hartford. He retired in 1988 from Combustion Engineering, Inc. in Windsor CT and then worked at the Veterans Hospital Engineering Department in Newington CT from 1988 to 1993. Vytautas volunteered many years as a scout leader for the Lithuanian Scout Association and was a parishioner at Holy Trinity Parish Church in Hartford CT. During his past time Vytautas enjoyed reading, fishing, swimming and vacationing on Cape Cod Mass. His parents Juozas and Vanda Pileika and his sister Dr. Danute Simkus predeceased Vytautas. Vytautas is survived by his wife Grazina; sons Vytautas and Rimas; daughters-in-law Deborah Pileika and Barbara Brosman; his grand daughters Ashley, Lindsey, Gabija and Deana.
