May 22, 1931 - October 31, 2014

Zoila Borda Cáceres, a long-time resident of West Hartford, Hartford, Lyme and Old Lyme, CT, passed away Friday the 31st of October, 2014 at Hughes Health & Rehabilitation. Born May 22, 1931 in Cotahuasi, Arequipa, Perú, Zoila is the daughter of Gerardo Borda and Zoraida Cáceres.
